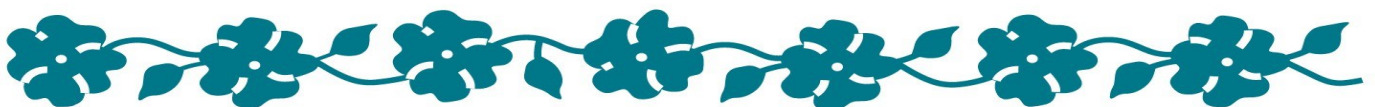
Caroll Langdon

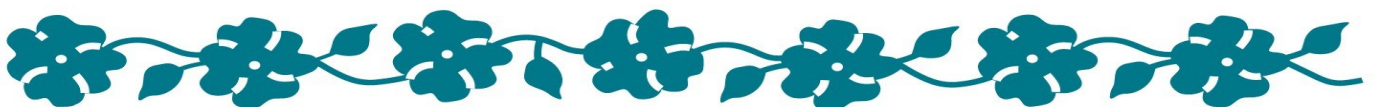
Jenny Tinklepaugh

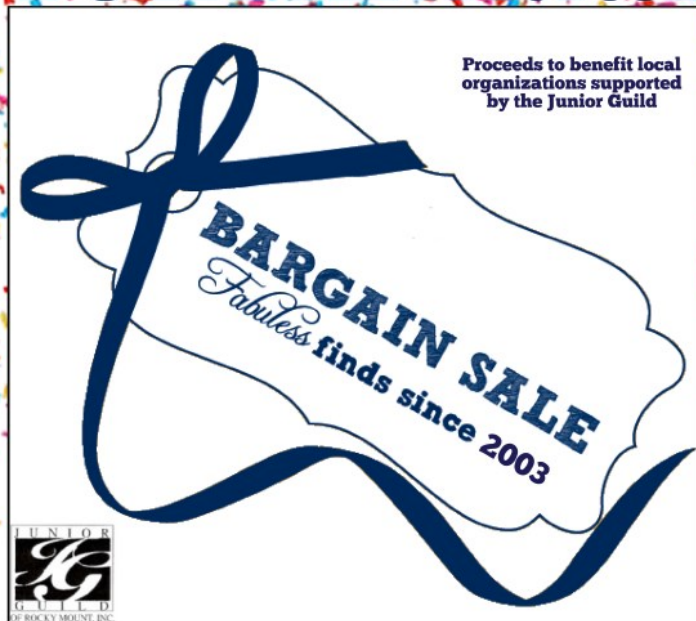


Renee Woodard

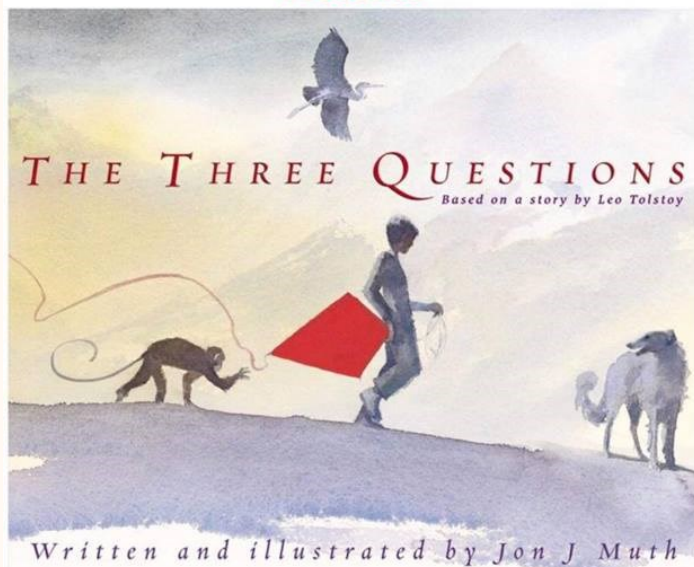
